If not, have you written a VAPG within the last three years that was not funded? Briefly describe the circumstances that led to non-funding.
4. What other grant writing experience have you had?
5. How familiar are you with agriculture, the agricultural community in North Carolina, etc.?
6. Please share any other pertinent information that you feel is important for the N.C. Value-Added Cost Share Program to know about you or your organization.
